3rd October 2019: Puppet Making

Puppets stimulate children's imaginations, enhance role play and encourage creative conversations. Learn how to make simple, quick and fun puppets for both you and the children to use in class.

5th December 2019: Working with Wood

The Arts & Crafts collection at the museum contains many inspiring pieces of woodwork. Use scrap wood and simple tools in projects, encouraging children's problem solving and mathematical skills.

6th February 2020: Working with Clay

Using the simple pinch pot technique and basic tools, try your hand at shaping and decorating the clay to create three pieces from three different ages: the Stone Age, Roman & Medieval times.

2nd April 2020: Reuse & Recycle

In this environmentally-friendly age, develop a variety of creative ideas to help children consider their carbon footprint.

4th June 2020: Wonderful Watercolours

Taking inspiration from Edward Wilson's work, explore some techniques in watercolour that will help you to teach children how to mix colours and create textures.

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
